The Animator/Educator – Bilingual position requires the successful candidate to facilitate education programs for primary, elementary, secondary, and post-secondary students through both verbal and tactile methods for French Immersion, core French *and* English-stream classes. Shifts are approximately 5.5 hours per day, from 2-5 days per week (flexible), during the school day, with occasional evening and weekend work. In concurrence with his/her responsibilities, the Animator will be required to:

- Facilitate Museum education programs in French and English
- Take responsibility for learning/researching current program curriculum & updates
- Present curricular messages in an accessible and engaging manner, through the use of experiential methods
- Deliver the Museum's education programs in a manner consistent with the approaches and content presented during animator training and as specified in the Program Manual
- Address emergent problems and group management issues in a fair and timely manner
- Communicate regularly with the Programs Coordinator/Teachers
- Contribute to the evaluation and improvement of the Museum's education programs
- Adhere to Museum policies and health and safety standards

Required Skills / Abilities:

- Excellent communication skills in French and English; other languages an asset
- Knowledge/experience/awareness of First Nations, Métis and Inuit histories, cultures and current issues
- Interest/experience in the story of the canoe and Canadian history
- Excellent group facilitation skills
- Well-versed in the philosophies of Experiential Learning
- Experience in teaching and/or historic interpretation
- Education/interpretation planning experience
- Musical ability an asset
- Canoeing, first aid, and swimming qualifications an asset
