The Canadian River Heritage Award is the most prestigious award recognizing river conservation and promotion in Canada. Historically known as the Bill Mason Award*, it is presented every two years to an individual who has made an outstanding contribution of **national significance** to river heritage in Canada.

The Canadian River Heritage Award is offered by the [Canadian Heritage Rivers System](#) in partnership with the [Canadian Canoe Museum](#). The award recognizes the invaluable efforts of an individual Canadian to celebrate, protect and conserve heritage rivers for future generations. Nominations are evaluated based on the **scope** and **impact** of their efforts.
