Museum Facilitators will be crucial to the design and delivery of our suite of experiential programming and tours. As the museum is set to relaunch on a new site, this position is an excellent opportunity to help create new programming offerings, be involved with the moving and installation of materials and equipment, and work with museum staff to implement a dynamic visitor experience. Museum Facilitators will guide interpretive canoe excursions for all ages on the Trent Severn Waterway, support special event delivery and lead hands-on programs.

Working closely with the Programs Manager, the Museum Facilitators will play an integral role in bringing the vision of a new Canoe Museum to life.

Successful candidates will:

- Possess excellent communication skills, including written, oral, and public speaking.
- Maintain a strong interest in community building and leadership development.
- Have a working knowledge of Canadian history, an appreciation of Canada's cultural diversity, and a love of canoes.
- Have a strong guest services background, preferably with tour guide experience.
- Fluency in English is essential; fluency in French or knowledge of an Indigenous language is considered an asset.
- Be able to safely lift at least 30lbs.
- Standard First Aid and CPR Level C or higher.
- Bronze Cross or higher (NLS preferred).
- Paddling experience, ideally in Voyageur (big) canoes (Paddle Canada Intermediate or ORCKA 3 or above certifications preferred).
- Current and clear Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Check.
- G class Drivers Licence with a clean drivers abstract. Experience with trailers an asset.
- Be eligible for [Canada Summer Jobs](#) funding.

Training in visitor services, program delivery, and tour interpretation will be provided.
